STATEMENT OF FAITH (cont. from last month)

S - We believe in the personality of Satan as a genuine, active, and malicious being, the arch-enemy of God and man, who, having willfully fallen from the estate in which God created him, caused the ruin of our first parents. He is now seeking to defeat God's purpose in the world and among His saints by the use of diabolical and subtle devices. God's judgment is that he shall be cast into the lake of fire forever. Genesis 3:1, 14, 15 Isaiah 12:14-17 Ezekiel 28:12-19 II Corinthians 11:14 Revelation 20:10

T - We believe the righteous at death immediately go to be with Christ in heaven, their bodies being left behind until at Christ's second coming they are raised incorruptible and reunited with their spirits and so shall forever be with the Lord. In like manner, the spirits of those who die outside of Christ descend into hell, their bodies being raised and reunited with their spirits at the Great White Throne, their eternal destiny from there being the Lake of Fire. Luke 16:22, 23 I Corinthians 15:35-57 II Corinthians 5:8 Revelation 20:11-15

U - We believe in the Genesis account of creation in that the God created everything out of nothing in 6 days resting on the seventh. We reject as "science falsely called" any type of evolutionary theory or other attempts to deny God's creative acts. Genesis 1:1-31 Exodus 20:11 John 1:1-3 I Timothy 6:20

V - We believe in the scanty of human life. We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life. We believe that human life begins at conception and that the unborn child is a living human being. Abortion constitutes the unjustified, unexcused taking of unborn human life. Abortion is murder. We reject any teaching that abortions of pregnancies due to rape, incest, birth defects, gender selection, birth or population control, or the well-being of the mother (unless the mother's life is at stake) are acceptable. Similarly, any type of euthanasia, mercy killing, or the like are also murder. Job 3:16

W - We believe in the eternal security of the believer. We believe that all the redeemed are kept by God's power and are thus secure in Christ forever. We believe that it is the privilege of believers to rejoice in the assurance of their salvation through the testimony of God's Word which, however, clearly forbids the use of Christian liberty as an occasion to the flesh. John 6:37-40; 10:27-30 Romans 8:1, 38, 39; 13:13, 14 I Corinthians 1:4-8 Galatians 5:13 Titus 2:11-15 I Peter 1:4, 5

X - We believe that Christians are prohibited from bringing lawsuits against other Christians or the church to resolve personal disputes. We believe the church possesses all the resources necessary to resolve personal disputes between members. I Corinthians 6:1-8 Ephesians 4:31, 32

Y - We believe that God has ordained and created all authority consisting of three basic institutions: the home, the church, and the state. Every person is subject to these authorities, but all (including the authorities themselves) are answerable to God and governed by His Word. God has given each institution specific Biblical responsibilities and balanced those responsibilities with the understanding that no institution has the right to infringe upon the other. The home, the church, and the state are equal and sovereign in their respective Biblically assigned spheres of responsibility under God. Romans 13:1-7 Ephesians 5:22-24 Hebrews 13:17 I Peter 2:13,14
